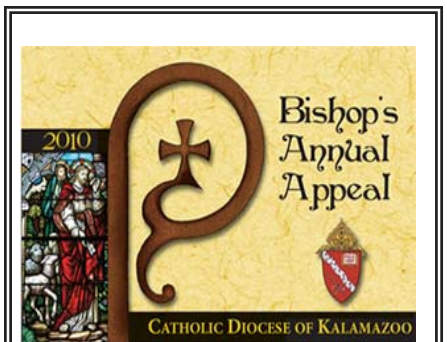

OPEN GYM

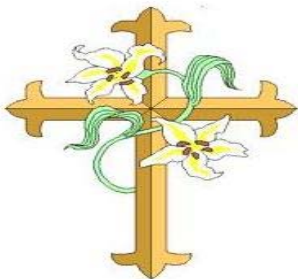
